

Advanced Academics Placement

Parents of private school students in Grades 2-7 may apply for full-time AAP services for the next school year. Screening files for Level IV Services are accepted ONLY during the noted windows.

All decisions regarding full-time placement in Advanced Academic Programs are made by a central selection committee. Parents or guardians of a student who resides in Fairfax County but is not attending FCPS have two opportunities during the school year to have their child screened for eligibility for full-time Level IV.

Screening files for Level IV Services are accepted two times during the year. File packets must be postmarked by:

- November 9, 2021 (Fall screening window)
- January 26, 2022 (Spring screening window)

Each second grade student will receive a AAP Screening Files including the following:

- Gifted Behaviors Rating Scale with Commentary
- Recommendation for entering Advanced Academic Programs (AAP) if qualified
- Ability Test Scores from the following approved tests:
- Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT)
- Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test (NNAT).

Both tests will be provided electronically. The timing will be offered accordingly with the FCPS deadline. Preparation for the formats of the tests is included in students' curriculum.
